The workshop will take place at the municipal center for environmental education – “Umweltstation” (Environmental Station).

Since 1990, the Environmental Station has been a centre for advice on waste, energy and the environment, as well as for education on sustainable development. It has received an

award from the Bavarian State Ministry for the Environment and Consumer Protection as a professional environmental education centre.

The Environmental Station is also the coordinating centre for Local Agenda 21.

For outdoor activities, there is a large meadow with old trees on the bastion, a park, herb garden and over 40 tree species nearby.

How to reach the “Umweltstation” | Niggelweg 5, 97082 Würzburg

By tram:

Line 2 or 4 to the *Neunerplatz* stop, from there it is about a 5-minute walk past the swimming pool to the environmental station.

On foot or by bike from the city center:

From the Alte Mainbrücke bridge, turn diagonally right up Zeller Straße. After approx. 250m turn right into Niggelweg. The environmental station is about 80m further along on the left-hand side.

By car:

Approach via Zeller Straße into Niggelweg either coming from Wörth-/Frankfurter-/Höchberger Straße or Dreikronenstraße/Saalgasse.

Public parking spaces are available in front of the house.
